THE RCIA AT ST. XAVIER "WE CHOOSE CHRIST"

In the dark and chilly evening of late winter, a group of "almost parishioners" of St. Francis Xavier will make their way to St. Peter in Chains Cathedral down the street and undergo the "Rite of Election."

The Rite of Election is a gathering of men and women from around the Archdiocese of Cincinnati who have been enrolled in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) throughout the past 12 months at various parishes. The RCIA is the normal way in which adults prepare to become full members of the Catholic Church. With hundreds of other "catechumens," they will be greeted by our archbishop and welcomed into the final stage of preparation to receive the sacraments here at St. Xavier at the Easter Vigil on Saturday, April 11.

At the cathedral these catechumens will experience the "election" of the Holy Spirit to bring them closer to life of the Church through their "yes" and the affirmation they receive from Cincinnati's successor to the apostles, Archbishop Dennis Schnurr. It is usually a very solemn and yet inspiring and joyful ceremony that is surrounded by Sacred Scripture, beautiful choir singing and fellowship among old and new believers.

Since October a wonderful group of nine people have been meeting on Tuesday nights in our parish center to learn about the Catholic Faith and to make it their own. They will be more visible in the church throughout the Lenten Season as on 3 Sundays they undergo the various ritual "scrutinies" that make sure they are ready for what is to come as Catholics. We will also have in the back of church their pictures and minibiographies on cards that you can take and accompany them with your prayers. The best thing you could do for them is to be present at the Easter Vigil on April 11 and welcome them into our faith and our parish community.

We are all looking for a greater sense of belonging, community, fellowship and connection with the Lord and His Church. Please be part of that quest for holiness among your families, friends and fellow parishioners both veterans and newly initiated. We are the Body of Christ present in the world as an extension of Jesus Christ Incarnate in our time and place.

Lenten Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are for Catholics age 14 onwards.
