# **Ah! These Jesuits!!**

Necessity is the mother of all inventions. they say. The Jesuits from the early days of their founding took innovative ways to accomplish their mission. Dispersed over

many countries and continents they adapted to new cultures, learnt new languages and established selfsufficient communities of faithful. One such effort was the Paraguay Reductions. If you have watched Robert De Niro who starred in **The Mission** produced in 1986, you will be amazed at the ingenuity of these early missionaries. What an incredible journey into those barbarian (savage) people and an amazing effort in winning them over and eventually building a completely self-sufficient community in the middle of the 18th century! What makes Jesuits so daring and creative, to break the barriers of language, culture, geographical terrains and preach Christ to the most inhospitable people?

The answer to this question lies in Jesus. He was a missionary. He broke the barriers of race, culture, rigid laws to reach out to people as we see in today's Gospel. Jesus breaks the boundary to enter a Samaritan village, for, Jews were forbidden as they were enemies for centuries. Again he broke the boundary by asking a woman for a drink from the well. All this risking of one's life, just to convert them to God's ways. The reason for what the Jesuits do is Jesus.

Three Jesuits were missioned in 1970 to a remote place where no one else dared to go. The terrain was treacherous with no roads and transport. People guite hostile because they were brainwashed by the Baptist church that the missionaries would destroy their culture. Against this background of hostility, seeds of Catholic faith were sown among Nagas people who were once known for head hunting. In fifty years, the little mission of three has grown to 150 Jesuits with over hundred young men, sons of the soil, training to be priests. That's the story of Kohima Jesuits in India. And I am proud to be part of that success story!

The secret of this success lies in adapting to the culture of the people; by eating their food, learning their languages and dancing to the tunes of their songs. Adjusting to a new culture is a daunting task. Missionary life is very challenging, especially when there are no modern facilities in interior places. Yet, the joy is immense. Because everything that you do reaches the most deserving people.

Pope St. Paul VI, addressing the Jesuits gathered in 1967 said, "Wherever in the Church, even in the most difficult and extreme fields, in the crossroads of ideologies, in the frontline between the deepest human desires and the perennial message of the Gospel, there have been, and there are, Jesuits."
