As you may know, the Archdiocese has dispensed Catholics from the Sunday obligation to attend Mass, until Easter Sunday. Further, the Ohio Governor has imposed a "stay at home" order until April 6. Our parish offices are closed during this time, and our Mass schedule is suspended.
