

Lenten Fast and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person may eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are for Catholics age 14 onwards.

We Would Like to See Jesus

In the opening line of the Gospel for the Cycle "B" readings, we hear of some Greeks who came to worship at the Passover ask Philip, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." What a monumental request. Taken in context it is simply a group of people who probably heard so many wonderful things about Jesus that they wanted to meet him. But if we take that line and apply it to ourselves, well, how many of us do not ask the same thing? We all want to see Jesus. The question we need to ask is: what's keeping us from seeing him?

All too often we simply pay no attention to Jesus. If guestioned about our faith and our practice of it, we are quick to respond that "Jesus is everywhere." This is a convenient theological understanding as the golf course beckons on a Sunday morning. As true as that statement is, we tend to overlook Jesus in the ordinary people around us: the elderly person who, whatever the weather, attends Mass every day, the person for whom menial work is a sacred trust, the bedridden person whose acceptance reveals an incredible faith. These are but a few of the many manifestations of Jesus. We spend our lives searching for Jesus, attempting to do what is right and just, all in hopes of one day-the final day-seeing him. For a God who is always with us, ever-present, always loving and nurturing us, does it seem to stand that he would be hidden from view.

Let us not forget the most perfect vision of Jesus we have this side of eternity, the Eucharist. With the pandemic keeping so many away from Mass, there is an increased longing to not only see Jesus but to receive him in Holy Communion. When we approach the altar, we experience Jesus and participate in his divine life. The Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist we receive forms us to become the face of Jesus to others. As we journey with Jesus to Calvary in these last few weeks of Lent let us pray for the grace to recognize Jesus in others and to mirror him in our lives. Deacon Tim Crooker
