

Are You An Easter Person?

The beauty of Easter is that it lasts for seven weeks. While the secular world returns to its day-in-and-day-out living, the Christian rides the crest of hope in the Risen Lord and the celebration of all that means for our lives. During Lent we focused on our sinfulness and mortality, and while we may not have immersed ourselves into the spiritual self-examination, we at least ate a fish sandwich on Friday hoping that would save us for eternal life. Contemplating one's own mortality is not a pleasant pastime. It causes us fear and trepidation and raising questions and doubts. What will I be in the afterlife?


The Gospel for today gives us some reason to be hopeful and answers maybe a few questions. After his resurrection, Jesus appears many times to his disciples (Apostles and others). He shows them the wounds he endured during his mortal life. He asked them to touch him and see that he has flesh and bones. To take it one step farther, he eats a baked fish with them. These are not what we have come to expect of our being—our bodies— in the life to come. But it helps us understand that there is indeed a life to come, and that we will have some kind of body, (though the Scriptures do not give complete detail, only to say that it will be a glorified body). Another aspect of Easter, of living in the resurrection, is that our quest for knowledge of God will be further satiated. Jesus explains to his followers again that he is the fulfillment of the law of Moses and the subject of the writings of the prophets. He opens their minds to understand the Scriptures.

We have the benefit of the Easter experience as well. We no longer live as people waiting in darkness and despair wondering who will come to lead us out. We are an Easter people, awash in the waters of baptism, full of joy and amazement, not only in that Our Lord rose from the dead, but that he demonstrated his power over sin and death for us! And what's more, he walks with us, encouraging us, teaching us, loving us into relationship with him, and our eternal home. We are an Easter people! Let us rejoice in Our Lord. Alleluia!
