Acts 9:31

All during this Easter season, we have been following the beginning of our Catholic faith. The fledgling church, created by Jesus and handed on to Peter and the disciples began with this small faith community. They were often afraid, but they trusted in the word of Jesus and wanted to share the Good News they had been given.

Some years ago, St. Xavier offered a Lenten program with Small Faith Formation groups. During Lent these groups meet once a week and studied the scripture for the coming Sunday. This "breaking open the Word" is a wonderful practice and made hearing the readings richer on Sunday. Most of these groups dissolved after the session was completed, but several groups continued long after. They studied scripture and chose religious books to read and discuss. After some time passed, they felt moved to DO something. One group traveled to an Indian Reservation. Another group asked to begin a food item collection which began prior to Thanksgiving and was completed in time to support local food pantries for the holiday season. Next came praying the rosary and inviting the parish to join in as well.

All of this seemed to follow the motto that is at the top of every St. Xavier weekly bulletin *Inward Reflection/ Outward Action*. It is very Christian, and very Ignatian. When we immerse ourselves in the Gospel message, the need for action simply follows.

This small faith community has grown close, and they have become friends. As others have joined them, they have been welcomed - again much like the early church.

Now, following a year of social distance and isolation, this small faith community has offered to host a parish picnic. As with all of the other initiatives they've begun, they have received approval from the pastor and coordinated their projects through the parish office. They have also taken complete ownership of their projects. This June 6th picnic would be a lovely start to the summer. It only, requires you to bring your own food and drinks, and enjoy the company of fellow St. Xavier parishioners safely.

The Holy Spirit is at work in this parish. The Ignatian *magis* has meaning here. There is always more we can do...just look around and join in!
