Following Him

We are not always the best judges of things. As Peter's plight reveals today, when he thinks he is done working, he might just be asked to begin again. Where Peter thinks he is a sinful man, Jesus calls him to become one of his disciples. The surprising feature of the gospel at this moment: Christ is always waiting to reveal more to us, both in our work, and in our sense of who we are, if only we follow him.

Sometimes it takes an abundance for us to believe that we are in the presence of God: something that we hoped would happen, *actually* happens (*who dey*); a goal we sought to achieve is realized; a problem that has plagued us is resolved. At these times, giving thanks to God might seem almost second nature. Perhaps, however, these things might not reveal an answer to prayer, but an invitation to a deeper way of living our faith.

In the song, Here I am Lord, we name the ways in which God is present in the world and the ways that we ourselves will strive to respond in imitation of Christ. Success is not necessarily a measure of effort, nor is it an indication of our worth. Rather, what we begin to realize is that when we work with Christ in our lives every day, our understanding of "success", "worth", and "merit", begins to change. We become aware of the desire to do good, even when exhausted. We become aware of the Spirit that allows us to respond with grace even when we feel unworthy. Most importantly, we begin to realize that it is our attentiveness to His presence at any given moment that reveals that which is truly good in our lives. The real point of success is this: that we are doing what we do with God's presence in mind.

At any given moment, it is Christ who makes us aware that when we follow him, each moment will have the capacity to reveal that which is truly good. When we experience success in one way, we might also be called to give thanks to God for all the grace we have received in other ways. When we experience failure, we might be called to be aware of how God is supporting us and calling us to something more. In each of these cases, perhaps it is not so much about what we feel we have "gotten", but what it is that we might be called to from here.
