Plain talk

Today, the "reign [of God] explained" stays "mainly on the plain" as we get the famous Sermon on the Plain. Welcome to Luke's version of the Beatitudes where location speaks volumes. Indeed, today, Jesus is on a plain looking at us eye to eye and urging us to "be an attitude" of faith. Notice that this is not Matthew's Sermon on the Mount where we have a top down lesson of the Beatitudes. Today, Jesus "gets down" to our eye level. What is the benefit of Luke's version? It is an "in your face" instruction.

On level ground, Jesus "gets down" to us in order to lift us up, for Luke is famous for showcasing Jesus' ability to meet people where they are - in their sickness, weakness, fears, and anxieties. To this end Luke uses the personal pronoun, "You," as in "Blessed are YOU," rather than "Blessed are THEY" found in Matthew's version. It's more personal. Indeed, Jesus tells us today to hold an attitude of blessed awareness that God loves us in our joys AND especially in our sorrows. He redeems sadness, persecution, humility, poverty, hunger, and illness, and he states that we are not alone. God is with us and we are blessed. In some ways these beatitudes on the plain are a Valentine's Day card where Jesus says Be-lieve, Be-assured, Be-aware, BE MINE for your place is with the Lord in the here and now.

If the Beatitudes describe the personality of Jesus, then can we put on the mind of Christ and hold onto his direct and heartfelt message that we will be okay during bumpy times? Sermons on jet planes usually include a reminder to put your mask on first in order to assist others and to fasten your seat belt in times of turbulence. Today's sermon on a plain reminds us to do same. Put on your mask of protection that starts with an awareness that when you are poor, you are still blessed. Hungry? You will be satisfied. Sad? You will eventually laugh. Aware of this assurance, we then fasten our resolve that if and when we suffer for the kingdom of God we are exalted in God's eyes.

I like plains and planes. They remind us of God looking directly at us and giving us wings. Today, Jesus reinforces this message in Luke's Sermon on the Plain as he stands before us and gives us a Valentine of blessed flight assurance. Plain and simple, God's reign is explained to ensure a fair treatment of all ladies (and gentlemen!).
