CINCINNATI JESUIT FAMILY

This weekend, commemorating the feast day of St. Ignatius Loyola, the founder of the Society of Jesus, St. Xavier Church comes together with Bellarmine Chapel to celebrate our first "All-Family" parish mass. We are united in this effort with members of the Jesuit works in town, St. X High School, Xavier University, the Jesuit Spirituality Center at Milford and Xavier Jesuit Academy. The celebration, therefore, is not only the first celebration coordinated by the new parish family, but a joint work of the many people committed to spreading the gospel of Jesus Christ in the tradition of St. Ignatius.

In the gospel reading designated for today's feast, we hear Christ call us to renounce all things that might impede our discipleship. The examples offered can seem extreme, especially because we realize that the foundation of the Gospel is Faith, Hope, and Love. In these examples, we see how we are called to look at even the most basic aspects of our belief and understanding, turning away from whatever does not align us with greater fidelity to serving the Body of the Christ. As we grow and mature, this requires constant change.

Speaking specifically of our continued work as a Jesuit parish family, this coming fall we will begin a deeper conversation to find ways to understand our growing relationship. As Jesuit ministries, we share a common *charism*, a tradition and a commitment to living out our faith. Like any siblings, while we share common traits, we also recognize our individual embodiment of these traits. Over the coming years, as these two parish ministries realign, finding areas of common ministry while also emphasizing those aspects which are truly unique to each sibling, we will find new ways to work together.

This celebration, however, is not only about the parish family, but also the continued commitment by the Society of Jesus to the people of Cincinnati. It is a celebration of the Holy Spirit, and the many ways in which the Spirit is embodied in the world. Thus, even more than a parish family, in Cincinnati, there is a family of Jesuit works. In the coming years, the Society of Jesus is committed to a continued coordination and amplification of our efforts to share the Gospel, that we might grow in our commitment to encouraging growth in mind and spirit in the Body of Christ.
