

Happy Birthday, **Ecclesial Body of Christ!**

Today, we celebrate Pentecost, fifty days after Easter Sunday. Nicknamed the "Birthday of our Church," it commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ while they were in Jerusalem. The Spirit is conferred on the Apostles to GO OUT and spread the gospel. May the Spirit descend upon you!

Actually, the Holy Spirit has already come to each of us in the Sacrament of Confirmation. Do you remember your Confirmation... and its implications? To help you renew your Confirmation and recognize the presence of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, we feature the color red, symbolizing fire and ignition. May all of us share in this "red letter day" as the Holy Spirit burns in all of our hearts. Let's not miss the opportunity to rejoice in a Spirit of love and mission that we, as a church body, can promote.

When I taught high schoolers about the Sacrament of Confirmation. I emphasized the fiery aspect of the Holy Spirit characterized by its seven gifts: Wisdom, Understanding, Right Judgement, Courage, Knowledge, Piety, Wonder, Which one of these gifts is speaking to YOU today? Collectively, these gifts push us to maturely live our faith -whether 14 years old or 94.

Recall your Confirmation when the Bishop conferred this sacrament upon you with oil and a hand shake (formally a slap to the face!) to jolt you into a fiery mood and ambitious mode. As a teacher, I tried to promote the zeal of the Spirit in this sacrament by doing a "hands on" project with my students involving origami (paper folding) doves - the dove being a symbol of the Holy Spirit. The students would fold and create a paper origami dove, write a spiritual message on the dove, and then take the dove into the marketplace and give it away to an unsuspecting person. This was to minimize anyone saying, as the people of Corinth did in the Acts of the Apostles, "We have never even HEARD of the Holy Spirit."!

Today, we not only hear about it, we feel it and we sense it. So to each of you today: Happy Birthday Ecclesial Body of Christ! We are jolted by this magnificent Holy Spirit to celebrate Pentecost and our own Confirmations in a fiery fashion.


