# "May it be done to me..."

Here we are at the fourth Sunday of Advent. We await the arrival of the baby Jesus. In today's Gospel, Mary receives a visit from the Angel Gabriel. Can you imagine what that would have been like? What about the message that Gabriel has shared with her? Mary's answer is "Yes".

It makes me wonder what ran through Mary's mind after this. She has gotten the assurance from Gabriel that "you have found favor with God" and that everything will work out. It makes one think that she would have doubts, especially in the circumstances in which Jesus was to be born. Whereas a poor family traveling the roads, a dirty manger for a crib, etc. It makes me think of a somewhat newer song for the Christmas season, "Mary, Did You Know?." This song has been performed by numerous artists, most recently by my favorite, Pentatonix.

Here are some of the lyrics to the song:

Mary, did you know that your baby boy would one day walk on water?

Mary. Did you know that your baby boy would save our sons and daughters?

Did you know that your baby boy has come to make you new? This child that you delivered, will soon deliver you.

Mary, did you know that your baby boy will give sight to the blind man?

Mary, did you know that your baby boy will calm the storm with his hand?

When you kiss your little baby you kiss the face of God.

The blind will see, the deaf will hear, the dead will live again.

Mary, did you know that your baby boy is Lord of all creation?

That sleeping child you're holding is the great, I AM.

Mary's "yes" to God points to her obedience to faith, to which we are all called. When we say the Our Father, do we pause and think at the part "thy Will be done"? By doing God's will, what plan may God have for our lives?!
