

Going Where God Leads

"Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men."

Then they abandoned their nets and followed him.

Mk 1: 17-18

No matter where you are along this journey we call life, there are times when you don't get to do what you plan. You might set life goals, book a trip, or decide on a career change – whatever the plan, God may have other ideas and alter your direction. I have often used the phrase, "We make plans, and God laughs." I think today's Gospel message depicts this perfectly. Andrew and Peter were worrying about their next catch when Jesus entered the picture. A life-changing event for them for sure!

What interests me is how willingly they obeyed! I often have had unexpected events change the course of my life. As I reflect, I am not sure I was as quick to follow the new plan that God laid out before me. I can usually see the value of God's intervention when I look back on the course of my life, but at the time, I often felt I had been plunged into chaos.

Recently, I have come to a new appreciation for these God moments. I am leaving my position as the Pastoral Associate for Marriage this month. While I know it is time for me to leave the work to someone else, I also feel uncertain about how this will change my everyday routine. But like Andrew and Peter, I have decided to simply trust that God's plan is better than any plan I might have for the future.

I am blessed to still be a member of the generous-spirited, loving, prayerful faith community of St. Xavier Church. That will not change. The people here have sustained me through some of my hardest life moments. I am very grateful that Kevin and I discovered this welcoming parish almost 30 years ago. This sacred space and these special people have brought me much comfort, peace, and joy.

The challenge today for all of us is to follow the example of Andrew, Peter, James and John. Let's drop the nets of our own plans and see the many ways God is changing the direction of our lives for our own good. Let's cast our nets wide and find our small ways to be fishers of men for Jesus.
