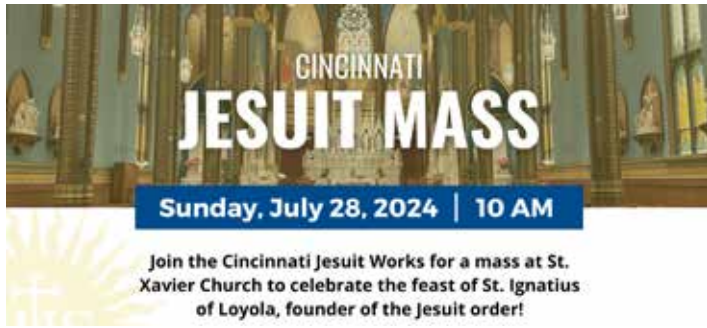

Troubled Waters

A maritime theme runs through the readings and the Psalm today. How do we weather the storms in our lives? Do we keep the faith “in good times and in bad”? Do we believe that God’s everlasting love can carry us through? The writer/philosopher G.K. Chesterton said that when you feel as if you are in a sinking ship with waves coming over the bow, become a submarine.

Job in the first reading and the Apostles in the second reading seemed to understand these teachings. But they needed to have faith in what they had learned. They needed to put their faith into action when dealing with the hand they were given.

Sometimes, I think about the Jesuit Missionaries of the past. What faith and fortitude did they have to go out on a ship to the unknown world. Going out on a ship at that time was filled with all sorts of peril. Going out into the dark, storms, sea monsters, etc. Have a look in the back of the church. We have a statue of Saint Isaac Jogues, SJ. As you can see, he is missing some fingers—particularly his index fingers.

It has been said that his fingers were chewed off by the Mohawk Indians so that he could not hold up the Eucharist properly. He was a prisoner for almost two years, traveling with the tribe, all the while being tortured on numerous occasions. Eventually, he escaped and got on a ship back to France. After a period of recovery, he decided to get back on a ship and return to the same area. Once again, he tried ministering to the Native Americans. He had faith that he would be successful in his endeavors. This time, he was not so fortunate and was martyred.

We are not all asked to become martyrs in maybe the physical sense. Are you willing to give of yourself to where you may have reached a “burnt out” stage? Do you stay calm during troubled times? Do you have faith in what Jesus has taught you? Do you prayerfully ask for Jesus’ blessings?
