# Preparing the Way of the Lord

Advent is a time of waiting and preparing for the arrival of the Messiah, Jesus of Nazareth. This Sunday's Gospel, however, focuses on another important figure in salvation history, John the son of Zechariah, also known as John the Baptist. Luke tells us that John was fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah to "prepare the way of the Lord." As Christians, we too are each called to take part in bearing Christ to the world.

In a recent pastoral letter to the faithful of the archdiocese, entitled *Radiate Christ*, Archbishop Dennis Schnurr reminds us that it is "the mission of each Christian to participate in the Son's redemption of the world." Advent is the perfect time to reground ourselves in this mission. When we talk of waiting and preparing, we don't mean sitting idly by while the mystery of the incarnation unfolds around us. This season is about actively detaching from the things that prevent God from dwelling within us. It is about doing the inner work that allows Christ to work through us, to be born anew through us.

Before coming to St. Xavier Church, my ministry was in affordable housing development. I managed the construction of single-family homes that would be sold to first-time homebuyers with income restrictions. It was always a delight to see the faces of families light up as they received the keys to their new home! But these projects would take months—or more often years—to complete. We had to select a site, develop the plans, bid out contracts, acquire permits, secure financing, and all this before any construction even began. I got a lot of practice in waiting and preparing! I'm sure many others can relate to this pattern, as well.

In a similar way, Advent invites us to lay the spiritual groundwork for our lives. These weeks leading up to Christmas are an opportunity to reflect on how we bear Christ to our brothers and sisters through our words and actions. What practices can we take up this Advent and beyond that will give witness to our faith and serve those around us? As John the Baptist says in John 3:30, "He must increase; I must decrease." What can we let go of that will allow Jesus to live more fully within and among us? May each of us take this time to honor our important role in the redemption of the world.


