# The Gift of Baptism

"I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" ... "Receive the light of Christ!"

Baptism is such a beautiful sacrament, a time when we are visibly "being transformed in the Body of Christ." Today, as we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we recall our own baptisms and all those baptisms we have participated in over the years—our children, our godchildren, our grandchildren. With love in our hearts, we remember these holy moments of family togetherness, these sacred moments when our closest loved ones were initiated into our church family as Children of God.

This paradigmatic moment of family togetherness was first established at Jesus' baptism found in today's Gospel from Luke:

After all the people had been baptized and Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, heaven was opened and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

Jesus' baptism marks one of the only times in Scripture where we find all three members of the Trinity present at once—a family gathering of divine proportion that we share in when we are baptized in the name of our triune God.

In his Angelus for this Sunday a year ago, Pope Francis asked us to contemplate the depths of what this union truly means: "Am I aware of the immense gift I carry in me because of Baptism? Do I recognize, in my life, the light of God's presence, who sees me as His beloved son, as His beloved daughter?" Our baptisms forever join us with God, grounding us in holy, loving relationship to all that is. Through baptism, a door is opened through which each of us can participate in divine Love, living out Love in our relationships to one another and all of creation.

As we recall our baptisms today, let us reflect on where God might be inviting us to practice greater Love. How might I live out my baptismal calling to love everyone as Children of God?
