Family That Prays Together

"There are different workings, but the same God..." So begins the verses from 1 Corinthians we hear today. The passage continues (to paraphrase): *Just as we have many parts that make up our human bodies, so it is with Christ.* In Christ, though many, we are one body, sharing one Spirit. Our goal is to recognize in one another our mission to serve, share, hope, and believe in the Gospel. As the Jesuit Parish Family, our parishes recognize sharing not only the same Spirit and one Faith in Christ, but also a tradition *within* our Catholic tradition.

Over the next year, our parish family will continue having opportunities to unite as one body. The Jubilee Year, focusing on the faithful as "Pilgrims of Hope," was announced through a papal bull last May. In late December, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati kicked off our celebration. Throughout this year, we will focus on different groups for whom we have been asked to pray. Recognizing in our parish vision statement that we are called to bear hope and healing, we will pray with the global church as pilgrims united by that same hope.

Beginning next week, January 24 and 25, we will have our Parish Family Winter Retreat. Titled "Being Transformed in the Body of Christ," the retreat allows us time and space to deepen our meditation on the Body of Christ, recognizing in new ways how His presence impacts everything we do. Our parish pastoral staffs will offer personal reflections of hope and transformation as we pray with the Eucharist, and with one another, as the Body of Christ.

Continuing into Lent and this second year of our Eucharistic Revival, each parish will offer different ways to pray. Book discussion groups, shared meditation, and a series of talks will help deepen our awareness of the Body of Christ. Our Lenten schedule will also offer a night celebrating the Jubilee Year's call to reconciliation and renewal. Finally, we will also begin a new process to engage membership in our councils and committees. This new process will be aided by a morning of reflection on synodality and its impact on how our parish community, religious and lay, joins Christ in service to all.

In 2024 we captured our vision, our hope of "being transformed in the Body of Christ to bear hope and healing in the Ignatian tradition." As we look to 2025, let us lift up our hearts in prayer as *pilgrims of hope*. In our collective journey as a parish family, may God bring healing for the broken and weary, and unity for our community, nation, and Church. May our parish family's commitment to our shared vision reveal the gospel of Jesus Christ alive in our hearts.
